Europe's East in the 20th Century. Historical Experiences in Comparison

For the period **1st March to 31st August, 2012**, the Kolleg invites applications for two Junior Fellowships from historians of Eastern Europe or related disciplines whose PhD should not have been completed more than one year prior to application.

The Fellowships have a minimum duration of four and a maximum duration of six months.

Fellows are expected to conceptualize a larger scholarly project which corresponds to the research interests of the Kolleg. They are expected to work at the Imre Kertész Kolleg and to reside in Jena.

Funding is € 3.500 per month plus housing allowance. Alternatively, funding can be provided to finance a substitute at the home university.
